In 2006 GFWC Kentucky convention body decided that it was necessary to put into place a fund that would be used strictly for the sole purpose of our State Headquarters Building. This original fund was named the 1228 Society which was reflective of our headquarters house number. The funds raised under this heading would be used for any and all maintenance and upkeep of our beloved building.

In 2013 GFWC Kentucky sold our Louisville headquarters and moved to Frankfort Kentucky. Our new physical address was and still is 104 Lakeview Ct. In 2014 the convention body voted to amend the name from 1228 Society to 104 Society.

In keeping with the format set forth by the 1228 Society we continued the levels of giving by using our house number as follows:
